New tech rules: Jeff Clark read the new rules in effect.

1. All Exhaust must exit out the muffler No cracks / No holes
2. The tire rule is in effect the rules are on the QMA web page. (reminder, QMA doesn't allow you to saran wrap your tires or cover your tires or the factory plastic wrap outside of your trailer at any QMA track or event. Dave Preston, National Tech Director)
3. Check all blue restrictor plates. Some holes are not punched out in the right location.
4. The nerf bar cannot be outside from the front and rear tire using a straight edge.**
5. Fuel testing rule is also in effect.

****Roger Dry will have a bar available so we can check our cars.**

QMA Safety Director recommendations: Please see attachment and read the QMA safety director recommendations on lifting cars up on the front bumper for repairs.

Fire extinguishers on pit carts: This used to be mandatory and would be a good idea for our members to keep one on their pit cart at all times.

No cam lock seat belts allowed, effective January 1, 2010.

End of year party: Date to be voted on at our next club meeting. (3/23/2009)

Novice: Novice extension forms must be submitted for novice over 6 years 3 MOS. Of age if they plan on staying in novice over 3 months.

Yellow rookie tape was recommended to be placed on roll cage of new move ups for the three probation races. This is for the safety of the rookie driver and allows other drivers to be aware of the new drivers.

The Novice Program Committee:

Novice Committee is staffed by the Race Director, Club President, Technical Director, Safety Director, and Novice Instructor. If it is the opinion of the committee a driver is capable of graduation into the Stock/Honda class, the committee shall notify the Handler verbally, sign the Novice Card and duly note in the logbook.
